Hay movement was put on hold for a bit by the snow. Generally movement is steady a few sellers dealing with wrapped hay have reported movement as being very good this year, more storms are forecasted for next week and if snow continues it should add some encouragement to the hay market, even with the still heavy supply of mid to lower quality hay. The Missouri Department of Agriculture filed a proposed amendment with the Secretary of State's Office to increase the subscription fee for the *Weekly Market Summary* from \$18/year to \$25/year effective July 1, 2004. The amendment was published in the <u>Missouri Register</u> on December 1.
