As November has arrived several new offerings coming to the market from areas with adequate fall rains. Producers are mostly done with baling hay this year and are taking inventory of any surplus they may have to offer to the market or else determining how much they figure to be short this feeding season. Prices are steady. **Weekly Crop Report**

Most of the state experienced favorable weather for progress in the row crop harvest and winter wheat planting, with both activities running very close to normal. The Bootheel was the exception, where soaking rains fell for the second week in a row. As a result of the rains, soybean harvest was slowed while the cotton harvest was completely stalled, although cotton picking is still well ahead of normal and farmers are glad to get the soil moisture recharge heading into winter. Top-soil moisture rates 8 percent very short, 29 percent short, 59 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus at the state level. There were 4.7 days suitable for fieldwork. Fall tillage is 38 percent complete. **Corn** harvest is 88 percent complete, slightly behind last year and normal. Most of the corn yet to be harvested is in the northwest district, with some corn still standing in the north-central and northeast as well. **Soybean** harvest is 70 percent complete, comparable with both last year and the 5-year average. Winter **wheat** is 65 percent planted, 4 days behind last year and about 2 days behind normal. Emergence is at 45 percent, slightly behind last year and normal.
