Missouri Weekly Hay Summary

This past week the western and northern areas of the state had some additional freezing precipitation, from a dusting to 6 or 7 inches, this along with seasonal colder temperatures forcing cattle producers to dig deeper into their hay piles. Most producers north of I-70 are fighting muddy conditions as the snow is acting as a layer of insulation and not allowing the soil to freeze, making it difficult to put out hay. Hay movement is moderate to light, supply is light to moderate and prices are steady.
