As the farmers get further along in the feeding year, many are finding more offerings available in the hay market. Trucking remains to be the largest obstacle in the equation. Except for the light supply of top quality Alfalfa, hay prices are seeing some pressure most of which is falling on the round bale market. Hay movement is moderate to light, supply is light to moderate and prices are steady to 10.00 lower. (All prices per ton unless specified)
