Missouri Weekly Hay Summary

Some areas in the southern part of the state are currently winding up what has been the wettest February on record. Most all areas, even those that may not have set a moisture record, are seeing no shortage of mud as temperatures are finally spending some time above the freezing mark. Hay movement and prices remain steady with what has been seen in the last few weeks as the number of feeding days left dwindle. The Missouri Department of Agriculture has a hay hotline available for both buyers and sellers.
