Missouri Weekly Hay Summary

After a weekend of many in the state seeing temperatures in the mid 70's Mother Nature quickly reminded residents that spring hasn't arrived yet. Although isolated and very sporadic, some areas received near a foot of snot on Tuesday. Hay movement and demand has been very good as farmer scramble to get just enough get through. Prices are fully steady. Hay supply is moderate to light.
