The Missouri State Fair opening this week signals the usual end of grass hay production here, however, this years' above normal rainfall, giving hope to many grass growers that there will be a second cutting of fall grass hay. Triple digit heat indexes this week slowing all hay production as we are in the middle of 3rd and 4th cutting of Alfalfa and most grass hay is already in the hay piles or barns. Even though tonnage may be up in the state this year, quality is below average as most grass hay was put up two to three weeks later than normal. Hay prices are firm; the supply and demand are moderate though demand still good to very good for the higher quality grass and Alfalfa.
