Regardless of what part of the state one travels to, once farmers get past talk of the economy, nearly every farmer you speak with comments they have never seen so much fall hay being baled before. Indeed if it weren't for the changing leaves one could easily mistake it as being mid June rather than the start of October. Much hay is being baled but hay movement remains slow and is unlikely to pick up a great lot till feeding gets underway. Fuel cost keep slowly dropping which could open some markets for hay if delivery cost keeping dropping. Prices on hay steady to firm; the supply is moderate to heavy and demand is light to moderate.
