Hay supply currently far outweighs demand as many cattle producers were able to stockpile fescue pastures this fall. Lower grain prices, the heavy supply of round bales and the general economic situation all adding pressure to hay prices. Despite the extremely high cost of producing hay this season, beef farmers are currently able to find plenty of 1000-1200 lb fair to good quality round bales in the 25-40 bucks a bale range which doesn't appear those prices even cover this year's cost of production. Hay prices are steady to weak. . Supply is heavy and demand is light.
