As February is quickly passing many farmers are taking inventory of hay on hand, some deciding how much they need to sell and others how many more bales are needed. Many farmers have also made a few trips or calls to the local fertilizer dealer checking prices and making decisions on which fields if any will receive it this year. Prices have fallen significantly since last year but still take a good chunk out of the pocket book. As feeding season is winding down and days to green grass are becoming fewer some farmers with a surplus of hay still in the piles are lowering their asking prices in hopes of reducing the amount of carryover but still cover the high cost of last years production.
