Rains heavy enough to put standing water in many fields and cause several creeks and rivers to surpass the banks put a hold on field work this week. Although many tractors are hitched up and the shop doors are open as some farmers eagerly await the new growing season. Hay sales in the state continue to be limited to mostly dairies and horse farmers. Beef farmers are reducing feeding as grass begins to grow, although for much of the state it will still be a few weeks before the grass can out grow the grazing and all feeding is completed. With conditions severely dry in states to the southwest there has been reports of MO hay getting rides to areas farther away now.
