Missouri Weekly Hay Summary

April's arrival has brought its normal extreme weather swings with it. Causing some days to begin in coveralls and end in short sleeves. Weather going from snow to 70 degrees in a matter of 24-48 hours is barely enough out of the ordinary to even start a good conversation. With some warmer days arriving Alfalfa producers are keeping an eye out for weevils that will likely begin to show up in the next two or three weeks. The USDA released the Prospective Plantings Report last week; hay is expected to be harvested from 4.10 million acres in Missouri, a decrease of 2 percent from last year when 4.20 million acres were cut but 1 percent above 2007. Nation wide acres harvested are expected to be nearly the same as 2008. Other data worth taking notice of is the 36 percent decline in winter wheat planting which if realized will be the second lowest level on record. Hay demand is light, supply is moderate to heavy, prices mostly steady. The Missouri Department of Agriculture has a hay hotline available for both buyers and sellers.
