Missouri Weekly Hay Summary- Week ending 12/10/10

Officially winter is still a couple weeks away but temperatures have many believing it has already arrived. Many farmers now feeding and chopping ice due to the freezing temperatures. With the rising price of corn, and the lack of high quality hay, a long winter could prove to be quite expensive. Everyday it seems as if more farmers are looking at alternatives, such as ethanol by-products, but even those prices have seen an increase in cost. With the lack of high quality hay available nearly all farmers will have to add some form of energy to feeding rations, especially once snow and sub-zero temps arrive. As typical, hay movement has picked up slightly as feeding season gets under way and progresses. State wide hay supply is moderate, currently demand is light and hay prices are steady. The Missouri Department of Agriculture has a hay directory available for both buyers and sellers.
