All heifers in the sale had met minimum standards for reproductive soundness, pelvic size, body condition and weight. A strict immunization program had been followed including Brucellosis calf-hood vaccination and tested negative to PI BVD. Heifers were bred to bulls meeting strict calving ease/birth weight EPDs. Several were synchronized and artificially bred. Projected calving dates were given with all heifers expected to calve from mid-January thru April 30.
