Missouri Weekly Hay Summary Week ending 1/10/2014

This week saw full feeding across all regions of the state. However most hay stacks look like they haven't been touched. The few sales that have been made are local trades on a few bales. Prices remain steady, with a heavy supply and light demand. The Missouri Department of Agriculture has a hay directory available for both buyers and sellers.
