Missouri Weekly Hay Summary Week ending 1/17/2014

Hay feeding backed off a little this week as temperatures were more moderate. Despite wide swings in highs and lows from day-to-day most regions were still comfortable. With a couple days even warming up to a spring preview, some hay sellers have begun to wonder where they will put the 2014 crop if some sales are not made. This led to the first slide in price we have seen in some time. Even with lower prices few sales were made, even fewer sales of large quantities moved. Hay supply is heavy, demand is light and the prices are weak. The Missouri Department of Agriculture has a hay directory available for both buyers and sellers.
