Missouri Weekly Hay Summary Week ending 1/24/2014

Another round of dangerously cold weather has settled over Missouri, although it is expected to be short-lived. Temperatures and wind chills in the negative have livestock producers hopping to keep enough hay out for their herds. The hay market remains cold this week as well, with little movement occurring. Hay supply is heavy, demand is light and the prices are steady. The Missouri Department of Agriculture has a hay directory available for both buyers and sellers.
