Missouri Weekly Hay Summary Week ending 03/21/2014

Spring has officially arrived. Daffodils and robins have both braved the unpredictability of Missouri weather and are harbingers of the warmer weather soon to come. With up to 72 percent of the state abnormally dry on the Drought Monitor, and 18 percent of that area having already moved to moderate drought, most producers are as awaiting the spring rains as much as the seasonal temperatures. It may seem early to worry about drought here, but there are areas of Texas and Oklahoma who are once again facing devastatingly low levels of moisture. Those are also the areas where hay is beginning to move on a regular basis. Some producers are also making sales to feedlots, but lower bids are being accepted to get the product moving. Hay supply is heavy, demand is moderate and prices are weak. The Missouri Department of Agriculture has a hay directory available for both buyers and sellers.
