Missouri Crop Progress and Condition Report
04/07/2014

Midweek rains throughout most of the state improved soil moisture and cooler temperatures continued. There were 3.0 **days suitable for fieldwork** for the week ending April 6. Reports of fertilizer applications were received statewide. **Topsoil moisture supply** was rated 6 percent very short, 26 percent short, 49 percent adequate, and 19 percent surplus. **Subsoil moisture supply** was rated 17 percent very short, 35 percent short, 45 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. **Corn** planting progressed to 2 percent complete. **Winter wheat** condition was rated 1 percent very poor, 10 percent poor 47 percent fair, 37 percent good, and 5 percent excellent. **Rice** planting has progressed to 2 percent complete. **Pasture** condition was rated 4 percent very poor, 24 percent poor, 49 percent fair, 22 percent good, and 1 percent excellent. **Supply of hay and other roughages** was rated 1 percent very short, 9 percent short, 80 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus. **Stock water supplies** were rated 10 percent short, 83 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. **Temperatures** ranged from 2 degrees above to 2 degrees below normal across the state. **Precipitation** averaged 1.92 inches statewide. Central Missouri saw heavier rain with Boone County receiving 4.36 inches. Districts 10 and 20 received much less rainfall.
