Missouri Crop Progress and Condition Report
04/28/2014

Corn planting progressed to 47 percent complete, up 21 percentage points from last week. Corn emerged progressed to 10 percent which is 5 percent behind the 5-year average. There were 4.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending April 27. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 1 percent very short, 19 percent short, 67 percent adequate, and 13 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 10 percent very short, 33 percent short, 52 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Winter wheat condition was rated 2 percent very poor, 10 percent poor, 45 percent fair, 38 percent good, and 5 percent excellent. Rice planting has progressed to 45 percent complete. Rice emerged progressed to 7 percent. Pasture condition was rated 3 percent very poor, 14 percent poor, 50 percent fair, 30 percent good, and 3 percent excellent. Statewide, temperatures averaged 61.0 degrees, which is 2.6 degrees above normal. Precipitation averaged 0.95 inches statewide. Some parts of southern Missouri reported heavy rain and flooding.
