Missouri Crop Progress and Condition Report
06/09/2014

Widespread precipitation slowed planting and hay cutting, with the state averaging 2.48 inches of rain for the week ending June 8. There were 2.3 days suitable for fieldwork during the week. Statewide temperatures averaged 72.4 degrees, 2.5 degrees above normal. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 2 percent very short, 13 percent short, 73 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 7 percent very short, 23 percent short, 63 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Topsoil moisture in the adequate to surplus categories increased by 14 percentage points from last week, while subsoil increased by 15 percentage points. Corn condition was rated 67 percent good to excellent. Winter wheat progressed to 61 percent turning color. Winter wheat condition was rated 53 percent good to excellent. Soybean planting progressed to 81 percent complete. Soybeans emerged progressed to 71 percent. Soybean condition was rated 66 percent good to excellent. Rice emerged progressed to 97 percent. Cotton squaring progressed to 11 percent complete. Pasture condition was rated 1 percent very poor, 12 percent poor, 43 percent fair, 41 percent good, and 3 percent excellent.
