Missouri Crop Progress and Condition July 14, 2014

Winter wheat harvest neared completion this past week. Harvest progress increased to 95 percent, up 12 percentage points from the previous week. Statewide temperatures averaged 76.2 degrees for the week ending July 13, which is 1.9 degrees below normal. The state average for rainfall was 1.27 inches. There were 4.8 days suitable for fieldwork during the week ending July 13. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 15 percent short, 77 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 3 percent very short, 24 percent short, 69 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Corn silking progressed to 79 percent, 51 percentage points ahead of last year and 22 percentage points ahead of the 5-year average. Corn condition was rated 84 percent good to excellent. Soybeans blooming progressed to 30 percent complete, compared with 6 percent last year and 22 percent for the 5-year average. Soybean condition was rated 77 percent good to excellent. Cotton squaring progressed to 65 percent complete. Pasture condition was rated 5 percent poor, 37 percent fair, 51 percent good, and 7 percent excellent.
