**Missouri Crop Progress and Condition August 4, 2014**

Cool, dry weather was present throughout the state for the week ending August 3. Statewide, temperatures averaged 70.5 degrees for the week, which is 6.0 degrees below normal. The state average for rainfall was 0.24 inches. There were 6.7 days suitable for fieldwork during the week. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 9 percent very short, 43 percent short, 47 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 9 percent very short, 40 percent short, 50 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Corn in the dough stage progressed to 64 percent. Corn dented progressed to 12 percent. Corn condition was rated 82 percent good to excellent. Soybeans blooming progressed to 76 percent. Soybeans setting pods progressed to 40 percent, 26 percentage points ahead of last year and 12 percentage points ahead of the 5-year average. Soybean condition was rated 74 percent good to excellent. Cotton setting bolls progressed to 58 percent. Pasture condition was rated 1 percent very poor, 15 percent poor, 43 percent fair, 37 percent good, and 4 percent excellent.
