**Missouri Crop Progress and Condition August 11, 2014**

Much needed rain fell across the state, averaging 2.34 inches during the week ending August 10. Statewide, temperatures averaged 75.6 degrees for the week, which is 0.5 degrees below normal. There were 3.5 days suitable for fieldwork during the week. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 3 percent very short, 28 percent short, 65 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 6 percent very short, 35 percent short, 56 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Corn in the dough stage progressed to 81 percent. Corn dented progressed to 34 percent, 22 percentage points ahead of last week and 16 percentage points ahead of last year. Corn condition was rated 83 percent good to excellent. Soybeans blooming progressed to 84 percent. Soybeans setting pods progressed to 56 percent. Soybean condition was rated 76 percent good to excellent. Cotton setting bolls progressed to 83 percent. Rice headed progressed to 66 percent. Pasture condition was rated 1 percent very poor, rated 13 percent poor, 43 percent fair, 37 percent good, and 6 percent excellent.
