Missouri Crop Progress and Condition
September 15, 2014

Rainfall and cool temperatures occurred throughout the state last week. Corn harvest was hampered in the northern districts where the largest rainfall accumulations occurred. There were 3.6 days suitable for fieldwork during the week ending September 14. Statewide, temperatures averaged 70.6 degrees, which is 7.5 degrees below normal. Rainfall averaged 1.67 inches statewide. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 3 percent very short, 16 percent short, 67 percent adequate, and 14 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 4 percent very short, 25 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Corn dented progressed to 96 percent. Corn mature reached 58 percent, up 22 percentage points from last week. Statewide, corn harvest was 12 percent complete, up 6 percentage points from last week but 14 percentage points behind the 5-year average. Corn condition was rated 85 percent good to excellent. Soybeans turning color progressed to 32 percent. Soybeans dropping leaves progressed to 16 percent. Soybean condition was rated 72 percent good to excellent. Cotton bolls opening progressed to 32 percent. Rice harvested progressed to 13 percent. Pasture condition was rated 3 percent very poor, rated 13 percent poor, 42 percent fair, 34 percent good, and 8 percent excellent.
