Missouri Crop Progress and Condition
September 29, 2014

There were 6.6 days suitable for fieldwork during the week ending September 28. Statewide, temperatures averaged 65.1 degrees, which is 2.5 degrees above normal. Rainfall averaged 0.03 inches statewide. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 4 percent very short, 23 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 3 percent very short, 29 percent short, 63 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Corn mature reached 87 percent, up 11 percentage points from last week. Corn harvest was 33 percent complete, 8 percentage points ahead of last year but 14 percentage points behind the 5-year average. Corn moisture at harvest was 19 percent. Corn condition was rated 86 percent good to excellent. Soybeans turning color progressed to 78 percent. Soybeans dropping leaves progressed to 48 percent. Soybean harvest was 4 percent complete. Soybean condition was rated 72 percent good to excellent. Cotton bolls opening progressed to 68 percent. Rice harvest progressed to 47 percent complete. Pasture condition was rated 2 percent very poor, 14 percent poor, 39 percent fair, 37 percent good, and 8 percent excellent.
