Limited harvest of corn and soybeans occurred last week, however progress remains behind normal. There were 3.5 days suitable for fieldwork during the week ending October 19. Statewide, temperatures averaged 55.7 degrees, which is 1.1 degrees below normal. Rainfall averaged 1.51 inches statewide. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 2 percent very short, 8 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 26 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 2 percent very short, 14 percent short, 72 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. Corn harvest was 58 percent complete, 17 percentage points behind the 5-year average. Corn moisture at harvest averaged 17 percent. Soybeans turning color progressed to 97 percent. Soybeans dropping leaves progressed to 89 percent. Soybean harvest was 25 percent complete, 9 percentage points behind last year and 21 percentage points behind the 5-year average. Soybean condition was rated 75 percent good to excellent. Cotton bolls opening progressed to 87 percent. Cotton harvest was 30 percent complete. Rice harvest progressed to 78 percent complete. Pasture condition was rated 12 percent poor, 34 percent fair, 46 percent good, and 8 percent excellent.
