**Missouri Crop Progress and Condition**  
**October 27, 2014**

Warm, dry weather allowed farmers ample time for harvesting during the week ending October 26. Corn harvest increased 10 percentage points from the previous week and soybean harvest was up 21 percentage points. There were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork during the week. Statewide, temperatures averaged 58.0 degrees, which is 3.7 degrees above normal. Rainfall averaged 0.04 inches statewide. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 1 percent very short, 10 percent short, 74 percent adequate, and 15 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 2 percent very short, 15 percent short, 76 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Corn harvest was 68 percent complete, 13 percentage points behind the 5-year average. Corn moisture at harvest averaged 16 percent. Soybeans dropping leaves progressed to 94 percent. Soybean harvest was 46 percent complete, 13 percentage points behind the 5-year average. Soybean condition was rated 76 percent good to excellent. Winter wheat planted progressed to 38 percent. Winter wheat emerged progressed to 19 percent. Cotton bolls opening progressed to 92 percent. Cotton harvest was 48 percent complete. Rice harvest progressed to 91 percent complete. Fall tillage progressed to 12 percent, 29 percentage points behind the 5-year average. Pasture condition was rated 11 percent poor, 33 percent fair, 48 percent good, and 8 percent excellent.
