Missouri Weekly Hay Summary

Winter weather continues to pound the southern 1/3 of the state. Although many farmers do still have adequate supplies of hay there has been an increase in interest from others as heavy winter feeding has taken a toll on the hay piles. Extended forecast has many hoping the last winter storm for the season is possibly in the books. By next week even the nightly lows look to be above freezing for several days, which should bring a nice supply of mud to deal with. The supply of hay is moderate and demand is light to moderate.
