Missouri Weekly Hay Summary (12/31/15)

Record breaking rain fall was the headline this week. Some areas of the state getting over 10 inches caused historic flooding causing major travel problems for nearly the entire southern half of the state. Some reports of lost or missing cattle. Colder weather seems to have set in now which is welcome once waters reside to help deal with mud. It has just been a very odd year all the way around and most folks are ready to see it go. Hay movement needless to say was non-existent. Feeding although quite difficult is starting to pick up as the diet requirements increase with the colder weather. The supply of hay is heavy, demand is light and prices are steady. The Missouri Department of Agriculture has a hay directory available for both buyers and sellers.
