Most of the state has seen at least some snow at some point now, but nothing lasting for more than a few days. Feeding has increased some but most cattle have likely tromped as much hay in the mud as they have eaten so far this winter. The market remains mostly inactive as many producers haven't gotten too deep into their hay plies that have grown quite large over the last two years.
