**Missouri Crop Progress and Condition (04/04/16)**

Corn planting is underway in Missouri with 3 percent in the ground as of April 3. Temperatures averaged 51.3 degrees, 1.1 degrees above normal. Precipitation averaged 0.96 inches statewide, 0.06 inches below normal. There were 4.1 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending April 3. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 4 percent very short, 14 percent short, 70 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 4 percent very short, 15 percent short, 75 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Corn planting was 3 percent complete, 2 percentage points ahead of last year but 1 percentage point behind the 5-year average. Winter wheat condition was rated 1 percent very poor, 4 percent poor, 28 percent fair, 56 percent good, and 11 percent excellent. Spring tillage is 27 percent complete.
