**Missouri Crop Progress and Condition (05/31/16)**

Rain throughout the state continued to slow planting and hay cuttings. There were 2.7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending May 29. Temperatures averaged 70.6 degrees, 3.7 degrees above normal. Precipitation averaged 2.42 inches statewide, 1.32 inches above normal. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 2 percent very short, 5 percent short, 70 percent adequate, and 23 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 3 percent very short, 5 percent short, 81 percent adequate, and 11 percent surplus. Corn emerged progressed to 97 percent, 13 points ahead of the 5-year average. Soybean planting progressed to 59 percent complete. Soybeans emerged progressed to 37 percent complete. Winter wheat condition was rated 1 percent very poor, 4 percent poor, 28 percent fair, 55 percent good, and 12 percent excellent. Pasture condition was rated 1 percent very poor, 4 percent poor, 40 percent fair, 51 percent good, and 4 percent excellent. Spring tillage is 96 percent complete, compared to 94 percent last year and 90 percent for the 5-year average.
