#### Missouri Crop Progress and Condition (11/21/16)

The state experienced dry conditions as fall harvest neared completion. There were 6.8 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending November 20. Temperatures averaged 49.9 degrees, 5.1 degrees above normal. Precipitation averaged 0.12 inches statewide, 0.75 inches below normal. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 9 percent very short, 25 percent short, 65 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 4 percent very short, 21 percent short, 74 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Soybean harvest was 96 percent complete, compared to 94 percent for the 5-year average. Sorghum harvest was 95 percent complete. Winter wheat planted reached 94 percent, compared to 95 percent for the previous year and 94 percent for the 5-year average. Winter wheat emerged reached 76 percent. Winter wheat condition was rated 4 percent very poor, 7 percent poor, 33 percent fair, 49 percent good, and 7 percent excellent. Pasture and Range Condition was rated 5 percent poor, 36 percent fair, 52 percent good, and 7 percent excellent.
