Missouri Crop Progress and Condition (11/28/16)

There were 5.4 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending November 27. Temperatures averaged 42.7 degrees, 2.2 degrees above normal. Precipitation averaged 0.31 inches statewide, 0.68 inches below normal. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 6 percent very short, 23 percent short, 70 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 4 percent very short, 21 percent short, 72 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Winter wheat planted reached 97 percent, compared to 96 percent for the previous year and for the 5-year average. Winter wheat emerged reached 84 percent. Winter wheat condition was rated 3 percent very poor, 6 percent poor, 33 percent fair, 51 percent good, and 7 percent excellent. Pasture and Range Condition was rated 1 percent very poor, 6 percent poor, 35 percent fair, 51 percent good, and 7 percent excellent.
