

# **Missouri Crop Progress and Condition Report** (07/31/2017)

Average temperatures were the rule for the week while the central parts of the state experienced heavy rainfall. Temperatures last week averaged 77.4 degrees, 0.1 degrees above normal. Precipitation averaged 1.25 inches statewide, 0.29 inches above normal. There were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending July 30. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 5 percent very short, 35 percent short, 59 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 5 percent very short, 26 percent short, 68 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Corn silking progressed to 96 percent. Corn in the dough stage reached 55 percent, up 25 percentage points from last week. Corn dented reached 4 percent. Corn condition was rated 2 percent very poor, 7 percent poor, 30 percent fair, 49 percent good, and 12 percent excellent. Soybeans blooming reached 69 percent. Soybeans setting pods reached 34 percent. Soybean condition was rated 2 percent very poor, 6 percent poor, 27 percent fair, 55 percent good, and 10 percent excellent. Cotton squaring reached 93 percent. Cotton setting bolls reached 30 percent. Cotton condition was rated 1 percent very poor, 7 percent poor, 31 percent fair, 53 percent good, and 8 percent excellent. Rice headed was at 56 percent. Rice condition was rated 1 percent very poor, 3 percent poor, 21 percent fair, 44 percent good, and 31 percent excellent. Pasture and range condition was rated 1 percent very poor, 5 percent poor, 44 percent fair, 48 percent good, and 2 percent excel-
