A Missouri producer that has worked to develop innovative agricultural products or services on their operation through on-farm

approaches. Nominees will be judged on current methods as well as their position to meet future economic and business challenges.

MISSOURI AGRICULTURE

EDUCATION LEADER

An educator or advisor in the Missouri school system highlighting the importance of agricultural education to our state's youth

MISSOURI AGRICULTURE EDUCATION LEADER while also advising them on becoming future leaders in the industry. This award recognizes teachers, advisors and leaders in primary, secondary and higher education systems. Nominees will be judged on the overall impact

they have on upcoming youth in the agriculture system.

MISSOURI FOOD ANIMAL

VETERINARIAN

A Missouri food animal veterinarian who has gone above and beyond. This award will recognize a food animal veterinarian who works to

protect animal health & welfare, prevent & relieve animal suffering, conserve animal resources, promote public health and advance medical knowledge. This individual must have provided veterinary care for the food production industry through surveillance for emerging diseases, and demonstrated best practices for animal health and well-being of food animals.
