Economic Contributions of Agriculture, Forestry & Related Industries:

Sales: \$7.5 billion

Jobs: 25,910

Value-Added: \$2.9 billion

Labor Income: \$1.6 billion

Inputs: \$4.6 billion

Taxes: \$535.7 million

Sales: The broadest measure of economic activity - often referred to as "output"; **Employment (Jobs):** A measure of job positions without regard to whether they are full-time equivalents; **Value-Added:** Sales (output) minus the cost of inputs; **Taxes:** Includes taxes paid at the federal, state and local levels.

Overall Contributions to Congressional District 5

Agricultural, forestry, and related industries support 25,910 jobs in Congressional District 5. Additionally, these industries contribute \$7.5 billion in sales, which translates to \$2.9 billion in added value to the area after \$4.6 billion worth of inputs are purchased. Of this \$2.9 billion, \$1.6 billion is comprised of labor income. Tax revenues generated by the agricultural, forestry, and related industries in Congressional District 5 are \$535.7 million.

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
