
Economic Contributions of Agriculture, Forestry & Related Industries:


Sales: \$19.3 billion	Jobs: 88,705
Value-Added: \$7.2 billion	Labor Income: \$3.8 billion
Inputs: \$12.1 billion	Taxes: \$1.3 billion

Sales: The broadest measure of economic activity - often referred to as “output”; **Employment (Jobs):** A measure of job positions without regard to whether they are full-time equivalents; **Value-Added:** Sales (output) minus the cost of inputs; **Taxes:** Includes taxes paid at the federal, state and local levels.




Overall Contributions to Congressional District 6

Agricultural, forestry, and related industries support 88,705 jobs in Congressional District 6. Additionally, these industries contribute \$19.3 billion in sales, which translates to \$7.2 billion in added value to the area after \$12.1 billion worth of inputs are purchased. Of this \$7.2 billion, \$3.8 billion is comprised of labor income. Tax revenues generated by the agricultural, forestry, and related industries in Congressional District 6 are \$1.3 billion.
