Sales: \$12.0 billion

Jobs: 60,732

Value-Added: \$4.3 billion

Labor Income: \$2.3 billion

Inputs: \$7.8 billion

Taxes: \$760.0 million

Sales: The broadest measure of economic activity - often referred to as "output"; **Employment (Jobs):** A measure of job positions without regard to whether they are full-time equivalents; **Value-Added:** Sales (output) minus the cost of inputs; **Taxes:** Includes taxes paid at the federal, state and local levels.

Overall Contributions to Congressional District 8

Agricultural, forestry, and related industries support 60,732 jobs in Congressional District 8. Additionally, these industries contribute \$12.0 billion in sales, which translates to \$4.3 billion in added value to the area after \$7.8 billion worth of inputs are purchased. Of this \$4.3 billion, \$2.3 billion is comprised of labor income. Tax revenues generated by the agricultural, forestry, and related industries in Congressional District 8 are \$760.0 million.
