

RESULTS OF TREATED TIMBER SAMPLES TESTING IN 2015

In 2015, 159 samples of treated timber were tested for adherence to established standards. One hundred forty one of these samples met those standards. 18 samples did not with all failures due to insufficient retention of the preservative. The overall compliance rate for meeting standards was 88.7% for the year.

These results are listed by treated timber producer and show results of testing their products in 2015.
