This label, the Engenia container label, and the Engenia supplemental label for dicamba-tolerant crops must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

Restrictions and Limitations

In order to apply **Engenia** to dicamba-tolerant soybeans and dicamba-tolerant cotton in Missouri, the following restrictions apply:

- **Wind Speed** – **DO NOT** apply at wind speeds greater than 10 mph. Applicator must measure and record wind speed and wind direction for each field prior to application.
- **Application Timing** – **DO NOT** apply before 9:00 am and **DO NOT** apply after 3:00 pm.
- **Certified Applicator** – All applications of Engenia must be made by a properly licensed Missouri certified private applicator or certified commercial applicator, certified noncommercial applicator or certified public operator.

- **Dicamba Notice of Application Form** – Certified applicators must complete an online web-based form “Dicamba Notice of Application” prior to the actual application. The Dicamba Notice of Application Form will be posted on the Missouri Department of Agriculture’s website at: Agriculture.Mo.Gov/dicamba/notice/.
- **Recordkeeping Requirements** – Certified private applicators, certified noncommercial applicators, and certified public operators must keep and maintain a record of pesticide use for each pesticide application. Recordkeeping items to be recorded and maintained for a period of 3 years are:
 - Certified applicator’s name and pesticide certification license number
 - Farm name and address
 - FSA field number(s)
 - Date of application
 - Trade names and EPA Reg. Nos. for all tank mixed pesticides
 - Estimate of the amount of pesticide(s) used and the actual rate of application for each pesticide expressed in reasonable and understandable terms
 - Start and finish time of application
 - Air temperature
 - Wind speed and wind direction, both measured at field prior to the application
 - Commercial applicators will maintain records of use in accordance with the requirements of 2 CSR 70-25.120 of the Missouri Pesticide Use Act.
