RESTRICTIONS/LIMITATIONS

The following apply:

1. DO NOT apply at wind speeds greater than 10 mph.
2. Applicator must measure and record wind speed and wind direction for each field prior to application.
3. Application Timing: DO NOT apply before 9:00 a.m. and DO NOT apply after 3:00 p.m.
4. All applications of XtendiMax™ With VaporGrip™ Technology must be made by a properly licensed MO certified private applicator or certified commercial applicator, certified noncommercial applicator or certified public operator.

5. Certified applicators must complete an online web based "Dicamba Notice of Pesticide Application" form prior to actual application. The Dicamba Notice of Pesticide Application Form will be posted on MDA's website at: Agriculture.Mo.Gov/dicamba/notice/
6. Certified Private Applicators, Certified Noncommercial Applicators, and Certified Public Operators must keep and maintain a record of pesticide use for each pesticide application. Recordkeeping items to be recorded and maintained for a period of 3 years are: Certified Applicator's name and pesticide certification license number, farm name and address, FSA field number(s), date of application, trade names and EPA Reg. Nos. for all tank mixed pesticides, estimate of the amount of pesticide(s) used and the actual rate of application for each pesticide expressed in reasonable and understandable terms, start and finish time

of a application, air temperature, wind speed, and wind direction both measured at the field prior to application. Commercial applicators will maintain records of use in accordance with the requirements of 2 CSR 70-25.120 of the Missouri Pesticide Use Act.
