**Chapter 2 – Missouri Minimum Standards for Property Boundary Surveys**

**PROPOSED RESCISSION**

**10 CSR 30-2.110 Location of Improvements and Easements.** This rule designated how and what improvements and easements had to be located and shown on a property boundary survey.

*PURPOSE: This rule needs to be rescinded as it is now incorporated into MDA's 2 CSR 90 Chapter 60. State land survey authority no longer exists within Department of Natural Resources, but now resides in Department of Agriculture. This change is pursuant to H.B. 28 (2013).*

*AUTHORITY: Section 60.510 RSMo 1986*

*PUBLIC COST: This proposed rescission will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.*

*PRIVATE COST: This proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred (\$500) in the aggregate.*
