III. WORKSHEET

This rule update is aligning state regulations with federal law. At the time of this draft, all existing filling stations are in compliance with these labeling requirements. Since all existing filling stations and future filling stations selling ethanol flex-fuel and biodiesel blends will be required to meet current and future FTC and U.S. EPA labeling requirements, there will not be additional costs to business owners as a result of this rule. Currently, there exists no ASTM International standard specification for biodiesel blends greater than 20 volume percent. The additional cost for labeling biodiesel blends greater than 20% biodiesel will only apply when ASTM International adopts a specification for such blends which is not anticipated in the near future.

IV. ASSUMPTIONS

The Missouri Department of Agriculture, Fuel Quality Program inspects all service stations and performs fuel quality analysis on approximately 8,000 samples per year.
