This week some areas finally added enough rain to the bucket to pass the inch mark for September. Moisture was limited to mostly central and north central areas. Most farmers are thankful that pastures grew well during the summer. Otherwise many areas would be feeding hay, especially to the south where pasture ratings have already declined to nearly 20% poor. So far, there have been no reports of any beef farmers supplementing hay. However, unless some moisture arrives in a hurry, it's a pretty good bet that hay will be unrolled before all the leaves fall.
