Little has changed this week in the hay market, buyers continue to search for hay to be trucked in for feeding, and each day it seems they have to go a few more miles. Corn prices have taken major price jumps reaching 10 year contract highs in the past week. This is leading to higher cost of not only the feeding of corn but by-products such as DDG's which have been used in order to feed lower quality hay. The cattle market has also taken major losses which is making it hard for farmers to decide to cut losses and sell with the low market or hold out feeding high cost feeds, and hope for a higher cattle market.
