**Missouri Weekly Hay Summary**

Little has changed in the hay market during the past week. Lack of extended periods of snow and winter weather in much of the state has been a small blessing allowing for just slightly less overall hay usage. Much talk going on in the local coffee shops about the effects that high grain and fertilizer cost might have on hay production in the coming year.
