Most high floatation sprayers are even finding ways to get stuck in extremely soft fields, others are forced to either hire planes to do their spraying or go without and risk crop loss, a very unattractive option. Some talk about new crop prices and numbers being mentioned are at or well above last years highs. However this talk really has no meaning as someone has to get new crop hay baled before anyone can really talk check writing. Weather has currently pushed corn planting to 3 weeks behind schedule, but with today's equipment we know a lot of ground can be covered if conditions will straighten out and the calendar is still showing some time before planting dates would equal yield loss.
