Every time there are a couple of days suitable for field work we have another storm move through. Most grain producers are more concerned about getting corn planted than hay production. Grass needing some seriously warm weather to continue growing as some areas report cattle keeping up with available pastures. This causes concern as to how much surplus grass will be available for hay as we already know that we have lost acres to either corn or soybeans this year. Hay prices are steady; the supply and demand is moderate.
